

JCA KESHER PROGRAMMING FEES

A flat Keshet Fee is required for all students (except JCAT) & will automatically be added to your registration. Additional programming fees are detailed below.

You must be a JCA member to sign up for Midot and B'nai Mitzvah classes.

POLICIES FOR TUITION AND FEES:

Before registration can occur, all tuition and JCA membership dues from the prior year must be paid in full and the current year dues form with payment (as per your family's plan) must have been received. \$200 Keshet Membership fee per student is due by August 1 as a deposit. Payment for the remaining tuition is due by September 1.

We refund all but \$200 in the case of withdrawal (e.g. moving, inability to meet a child's needs) within the first month of school. THERE IS NO REFUND AFTER YOUR CHILD'S FIRST MONTH OF SCHOOL.

We pro-rate a reduction in tuition in the case of "late" enrollment for NEW JCA members after November 1st.

FINANCIAL NEED

It is important to the JCA that children be able to attend JCA School regardless of family financial need. We work hard to provide assistance to as many families as possible. If your family will be applying for financial assistance it is important that you complete a [scholarship request form](#) as soon as possible by emailing it to JCA Administrative Director, Ann Wetherbee.
